

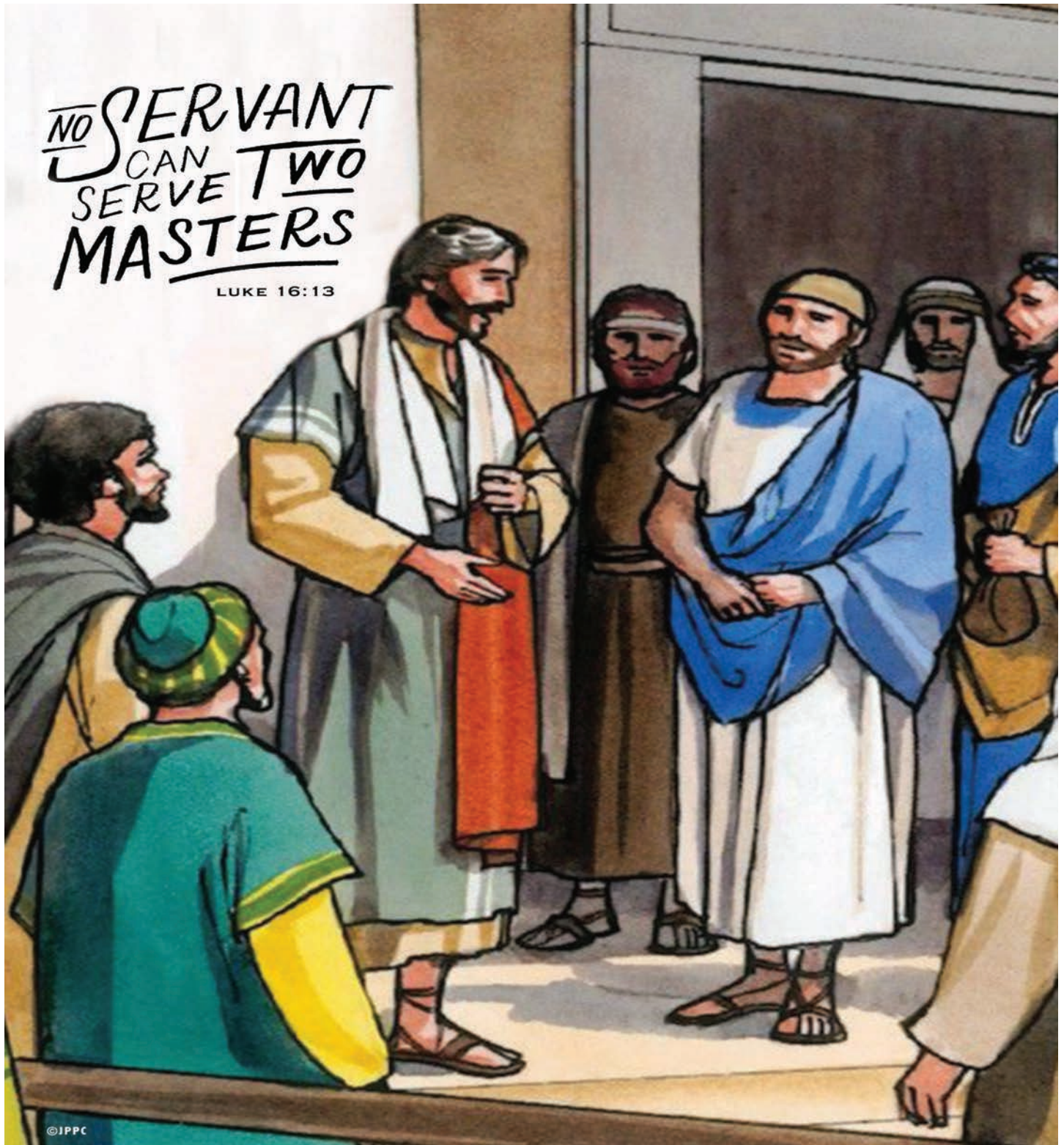

## PASTOR'S CORNER

**"Prepare a full account of your stewardship."**  
-- Luke 16:1-13

Today, Jesus tells of a steward or manager of another man's wealth. An audit reveals his dishonesty. He needs to act quickly, for his future is in jeopardy. So he reduces the amount of money others owe to his master. Most likely, he is giving up his exorbitant commission that he would charge. Jesus is not admiring his dishonesty but his prudence. His fiscal manipulation is not to be imitated, but his clever and prompt way of securing his future.

We are all stewards of the gifts God gives to us...our life, family, faith, wealth, and possessions that the Lord entrusts to us. The gospel question is how are we managing these gifts? Are we as eager and ingenious in our desire for spiritual wealth as we are with worldly wealth? If we use these gifts responsibly, generously, and honestly, the Lord will gladly entrust us with that true wealth - the wealth that lies beyond the here and now.

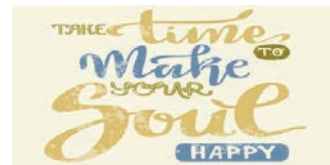

*RCIA, or Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults, is the process by which people who are interested in learning about the Catholic Faith can attend classes and have the opportunity to become members of the Catholic Church.*

### RCIA is for adults who:

- Are interested in learning about the Catholic Faith
- Have never been baptized
- Have been baptized in another Christian faith and are interested in the Catholic faith
- Are baptized Catholics who have not yet received Sacraments of First Communion & Confirmation
- Are married to a Catholic and attend Mass, and would like to take the next steps to become a member of the Catholic Church

RCIA is a spiritual formation process beginning in October and ending with initiation in the Catholic Church at the Easter Vigil. RCIA classes are taught by Father Murray and are held every Monday from 7:00-8:30pm at the rectory. These classes are for anyone with interest, no matter your current denomination. ## ST HILARY'S EAGLES FOOTBALL BLOCK POOL

The pool will include the final 16 games of our PHILADELPHIA EAGLES season, and will raise funds for our parish and CYO. 1<sup>st</sup> game will be on Monday, 9/19 vs Minnesota Vikings



Here is how it works:

Blocks will be sold for **\$80.00** each (\$5 per week, for 16 weeks).  
Semi-annual payment plan will be available.



The pool administrator will randomly place your names on the 1<sup>st</sup> week's grid, until the grid is full. That grid will then be copied for all 16 weeks. Your designated block stays the same all season. At that time, numbers from 0 to 9 will be randomly chosen for each week, for both the Eagles and their opponent. The numbers along the top and side will be different each week, so each block has the same chance of winning. The completed blocks will be circulated through email and hard copies will be available before the opening game kickoff.

The score at the end of regulation (not overtime) will be used to decide each week's winner.

The unit digit from each team's score will be used as lookups to determine the winning participant. For example, Eagles 41 versus New England PATSIES 33, we would use Eagles 1 and PATSIES 3 as the lookups. Each weekly winner will receive \$250 sent out by the pool's administrator.

We estimate that the Parish/CYO will pay out \$4,000 in prizes, and make \$4,000 to offset a variety of costs, for each grid of 100 blocks.

Blocks can be purchased by phone or email to Bob (maybe at church as well).

## MEN AND WOMEN OF THE EUCHARIST

For 2,000 years, Christ in the holy Eucharist has been adored. Ever since Jesus gave himself to us in the consecrated bread and wine at the last Supper, He has been with us in the Mass and in Eucharistic Adoration. Yet, so many Catholics, not to mention people of other faiths or no faith at all, do not believe in the Real Presence of God Himself, humbled in the form of bread and wine. In this era of disbelief, and especially as the U.S. bishops launch the National Eucharistic Revival, we turn to those who have paved the way for us believers. We turn to the saints who had a great devotion to the Eucharist and helped perpetuate greater love for Christ made present to us. In this and future bulletins, we will follow 11 saints, blessed and venerables whose lives were ordered around the Eucharist and to whom we have to thank for passing along the gift of Eucharistic faith.

**BLESSED JAMES ALBERIONE** entered into the seminary in his native Italy at age 16. Then, during an all-night Eucharistic vigil on New Year's Eve, 1900, Alberione began to discern a call to serve the men and women of the new century with the various forms of new media that would emerge in the following decades. The Pauline Family - five religious congregations, four secular institutes, and an association of lay cooperators - was born from this experience. The Eucharist fuels the Pauline spirituality, which strengthens the faithful, in Alberione's words, "to spread the sweet odor of Christ." He also adds: "The Eucharist directs our mission as "Christ and his grace are brought everywhere." Alberione developed Pauline spirituality with a Eucharistic Holy Hour as a constituent part of each day. He described it as "an audience or school, where the disciple engages with the Divine Master."
