PASTOR'S CORNER

“Would that all the people of the Lord were prophets.”

In the Scriptures, prophets were not to be understood as soothsayers, fortune tellers, or predictors of the future. A true prophet was one who tried to live in a right relationship with God. For Jesus, anyone who gives a cup of water to someone in His name can be a prophet. Any good deed done in the name of Jesus Christ, no matter how great or small, shows we belong to Him. Yet living in a right relationship with God can sometimes be controversial, such as standing up for the protection of the unborn, traditional marriage, and advocating for care of the elderly or terminally ill against laws promoting so-called “mercy killing.” Simply being at Church worshipping God can be prophetic in a culture that dismisses faith.

We live in a culture that is obsessed with looking good. People go to any length, endure any pain, and pay any price for a bodily makeover. Yet real beauty is not found in looking good, but being good. Jesus calls us all for a spiritual makeover. This spiritual makeover can be painful too, as if someone is “cutting off your hand or plucking your eye.” To put God and His priorities first, and living right with Him, calls for sacrifice. The results will enable us to realize our true and best selves.

Jesus comes to change bread and wine into His Body and Blood. Think of what He can change in us! Whatever is defective in our spirits, He can perfect. May we embrace our prophetic calling to be found to be a holy people, moral and just, in His sight. Let us decide for heaven once again...a decision that has everlasting results!

UPDATE TO THE ST. HILARY CAPITAL CAMPAIGN



We are now completing our two-year Capital Campaign. As previously noted, our original goal was \$350,000. The generosity of our parishioners has been overwhelming. A total of \$427,176.25 had been pledged. Of that amount, we have collected and deposited \$403,773. Of the 231 families who have pledged, 202 families are paid in full. All of our projects have been completed, and all bills are now paid, thanks to you! I hope you enjoy our new air conditioning system in the Church. Our children and teachers kept cool with our brand new school air conditioning system. Our new lighting in the parking lot and the new beautiful side Church doors have been a most welcome addition as well. Thank you to those who are still paying toward their pledge. So, as we are now in the completion stage of our Campaign, I remain most grateful for your kind generosity.

- Have never been baptized
- Have been baptized in another Christian faith and are interested in the Catholic faith
- Are baptized Catholics who have not yet received the Sacraments of First Communion and Confirmation
- Are married to a Catholic & attend Mass, and would like to become a member of the Catholic Church

OCIA is a spiritual formation process beginning in October and ending with initiation in the Catholic Church at the Easter Vigil. OCIA classes are taught by Father Murray and are held every Monday evening from 7:00-8:30pm at the rectory. Please encourage your friends and neighbors with interest in Catholicism, too! Our parish is celebrating a special devotion called Forty Hours on October 20-21-22. Services will begin at 7:00pm each of these evenings. Forty Hours devotion is an ancient devotion praising & honoring the Lord Jesus Christ present in the Holy Eucharist. This devotion was introduced to the United States by Saint John Neumann, 4th Bishop of Philadelphia, in 1853. The Forty Hours devotion consists of Songs, Prayers, Reflections on God's Word, and Benediction. On Tuesday, Oct. 22, there is a special procession around the Church with the Blessed Sacrament, symbolizing the call of Jesus "to come & follow me."

We are asking our families to come and participate in some or all of these devotions. It is one way to give thanks and praise to God for all His love. As Catholics we believe that Jesus is present in a special way in the Holy Eucharist. By coming to Him, we can be certain to receive much needed blessings and graces to help us in our journeys in life, especially in troubling times.

Our Forty Hours devotion begins at the 10:30am Mass on Sunday, October 20. The church will be open all day for private visits to the Blessed Sacrament on Sunday, Monday & Tuesday. Evening services will be held at 7:00pm each of those nights.

Msgr. Hugh Joseph Shields was ordained a priest for the Archdiocese of Philadelphia in 1972 and served in several parishes in Philadelphia. He received permission to join the St. James the Apostle Missionary Society for 13 years. He ministered in Peru, Bolivia, and Ecuador. Also, he lived and worked in administration in Boston with the St. James Society. Returning to Philadelphia, he served in several parishes, with a 5 year interval as the Vicar for the Hispanic Catholic Community. He retired from the role of "pastor" at St. Thomas Aquinas parish in South Philadelphia in 2020 and presently lives at St. John the Baptist Parish. We're happy he'll be here with us!

Sister Ana began her professional career in Occupational Therapy, which she continued after entering the Congregation in 2000. Since then, she has served in many roles in the congregation, such as the Province Vocation and Formation Director, accompanying women in their discernment of God's call. She served a term on the Province Leadership Team and currently oversees Redeemer Valley Farm, connecting individuals with creation and community through sustainable agriculture. The Pope's Encyclical, "Laudato Si" has been a great inspiration to her. We look forward to Sister Ana joining us!

EUCHARISTIC ENCOUNTER WEEKEND ~ We will be celebrating the life of Blessed Carlo Acutis, soon to be canonized a saint, on the **weekend of October 19th to October 22**. We are honored to be able to host the Blessed Carlo Acutis Eucharistic Miracles; they will be displayed in our Parish Center. Blessed Carlo Acutis was a remarkable boy. At a very early age, he developed a great love for the Lord in the Blessed Sacrament even though his parents were not practicing their faith. He encountered faith through people who worked for the family and townsfolk who attended daily Mass. As he grew to adolescence, he was involved in technology and had a great proficiency, beyond his age. He developed a website that cataloged all the Eucharistic Miracles. He cared for the outcast among his peers and was known for his joy-filled charity. On October 1, 2006, he was diagnosed with acute promyelocytic leukemia and died 11 days later. Immediately people came to pay their appreciation for the kindness & love this young man showed them. Soon people were seeking his intercession in prayer. He was beatified by Pope Francis in 2020.
