

PASTOR'S CORNER

"Enter by the narrow door."

GPS devices in our cars have replaced paper maps, but this new technology is not perfect. GPS devices can break down. Looking for a new doctor's office one time, I used my GPS and it sent me to a dead end street. Jesus Christ has come among us to give direction to God's Kingdom. It is His Word, which is not new technology but has been with us since the beginning, that leads us to our final destination.

The world is constantly misdirecting us. We can make a wrong turn by being caught up in worldly ways. It may be the pursuit of wealth at all cost. It may be our slipping away from prayer or the sacraments. Or it could be our egos preventing us from letting go of hurts and ignoring the call and the way of Jesus - to love by seeking the good in others. The direction and ways of the world will lead us to a dead end.

Jesus calls us to enter by the "narrow door." It means taking on the discipline of gospel values. We, at times, can become overweight with worldly values; overweight with pride or anger. Some of the most devastating words in Scripture are found in the gospel. Jesus says to those who come before Him, "I do not know where you are from!" How will the Lord recognize us? He will, simply by saying "yes" to His ways and following His direction. As St. Paul reminds us, "Do not disdain the discipline of the Lord; for whom the Lord loves He disciplines." The narrow way of Jesus will lead us to the joys of His Kingdom.


ST. HILARY CAPITAL CAMPAIGN

- Have been baptized in another Christian faith and are interested in the Catholic faith
- Are baptized Catholics who have not yet received Sacraments of First Communion & Confirmation
- Are married to a Catholic and attend Mass, and would like to take the next steps to become a member of the Catholic Church

RCIA is a spiritual formation process beginning in October and ending with initiation in the Catholic Church at the Easter Vigil. RCIA classes are taught by Father Murray and are held every Monday from 7:00-8:30pm at the rectory. These classes are for anyone with interest, no matter your current denomination. MEN AND WOMEN OF THE EUCHARIST

For 2,000 years, Christ in the holy Eucharist has been adored. Ever since Jesus gave himself to us in the consecrated bread and wine at the last Supper, He has been with us in the Mass and in Eucharistic Adoration. Yet, so many Catholics, not to mention people of other faiths or no faith! at all, do not believe in the Real Presence of God Himself, humbled in the form of bread and wine. In this era of disbelief, and especially as the U.S. bishops launch the National Eucharistic Revival, we turn to those who have paved the way for us believers. We turn to the saints who had a great devotion to the Eucharist and helped perpetuate greater love for Christ made present! to us. In this and future bulletins, we will follow 11 saints, blesseds and venerables whose lives were ordered around the Eucharist and to whom we have to thank for passing along the gift of Eucharistic faith.

POPE ST. JOHN PAUL II promoted Eucharistic renewal in the life of the Church, so that Catholics could truly come to recognize the sacrament as the source and summit of its life and activity. He invited Catholics to restore "Eucharistic amazement" to their spiritual lives and wanted "to banish the dark clouds of unacceptable doctrine and practice, so that the Eucharist will continue to shine forth in all its radiant mystery." And he led the way by example. "Let Jesus, present in the Blessed Sacrament, speak to your hearts," he said in 1997. "It is He who is the true answer of life that you seek. He stays here with us; He is God with us."


